



GENERAL INFORMATION ON CHILTON SAINT JAMES SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIPS

Chilton Saint James School offer Academic, Sport, Music, Dance, Chilton Ballet Academy, Principal and Chilton Old Girls' Association Scholarships.

Academic Scholarships for entry into Years 7, 10 and 11 are awarded to students based on the results of an academic examination in English, Mathematics and General Knowledge.

Academic Scholarships for entry into Years 12 and 13 are awarded to students based on outstanding academic achievement in Years 11 and 12.

Scholarship applications can be submitted at any time before the closing date of 4.00pm, Friday 3 August 2018. All applications will be acknowledged.

Academic Scholarship testing for all applicants will be held at school at 3.00pm, Saturday 11 August 2018. There will be three papers – English, Mathematics and General Knowledge. All candidates need to sit the papers on the same day and under the same conditions. If any candidate is not available on this day, their Scholarship application will not proceed.

All Scholarship applicants will have a personal interview with the Principal.

Please Note

- Overall academic ability, participation in sport, community and cultural activities and school achievements are taken into account when scholarship applications are reviewed
- The majority of scholarships offered are merit based and are for a portion of tuition fees. The value of each scholarship is to a maximum of 50% of tuition fees
- Scholarship applicants must be New Zealand citizens or hold New Zealand residency visas
- Students may only hold one Chilton scholarship at any one time. If a student holds a Suzanne Duncan Trust Scholarship or any other external scholarship, they are not eligible for a Chilton Saint James Scholarship or a sibling discount
- In the event of there being no applicant who reaches a sufficiently high standard, a scholarship may not be awarded
- The decision of the Principal is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

Please note: External applicants are required to pay a non-refundable Application Fee of \$200 to accompany all scholarship applications. If applicants are applying for more than one scholarship, they are only required to pay \$200.
